

NewDawn School Profile

Overview NewDawn School is a private institution situated on a spacious 2-acre campus along the Bondo-Kisian Highway, just outside Bondo town. The school serves the educational needs of Bondo Sub-County, benefiting from the area’s diverse economic base and welcoming a culturally varied student body.

Enrollment and Structure Founded in 2016, NewDawn School currently enrolls over 400 learners, including more than 200 students in grades 1–6 and over 230 in Early Childhood Development classes. The school comprises Pre-primary (Playgroup, Pre-primary 1 and 2), Primary (Grades 1–6), and a recently introduced Junior School, which began in 2025 and now has 20 learners. The staff includes 18 teachers and 10 non-teaching personnel.

Curriculum and Programs The academic program is based on the National Competency Based Curriculum (CBC) and is fully registered with the Ministry of Education. English is the language of instruction for all students and staff. In addition to the CBC, the school offers enrichment activities such as music (with instruction in drums, guitar, violins, violas, cello, and digital keyboard), weekly storybook sessions to foster reading culture, and French language classes for Grades 4–6. The school also organizes spelling bees and debates to enhance language skills and plans to introduce more life skills, such as culinary arts, in the future.

Extracurricular Activities NewDawn School provides a robust extracurricular program designed to support holistic development. Learners participate in music lessons, with access to a variety of instruments, and engage in weekly storybook sessions to encourage reading beyond the classroom. The school hosts spelling bees and debates, promoting public speaking and language proficiency. Plans are underway to expand offerings with additional life skills activities, including culinary arts.

Facilities The school’s facilities include dedicated spaces for Early Childhood Development and Primary education, as well as specialized areas for music instruction equipped with a drumset, guitar, violins, violas, cello, and digital keyboard.

The Junior School is fully digitized with each classroom equipped with smart boards.

The campus spans over 2 acres, providing ample space for academic, recreational, and extracurricular activities. The school is committed to maintaining a safe and supportive environment for both learners and staff.
